- Costs Range from \$6,000-\$7,000. Many fundraising options are available and local clubs may cover room and board
- Costs will vary depending on the local club
- Requires written application and support documentation. See requirements on website.
- Students must volunteer for at least 3 community service events before going abroad and upon return, make presentations to the Salida School Board and/or the Rotary Club.
